MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES

Please read these important guidelines before signing and submitting your 2010/2011 membership application.

Annual Membership may be paid by check, over the phone or at www.yiaishlv.com (via PayPal) with your Visa, MasterCard or AMEX credit cards.

Applicants may choose one of two payment plans:

- Fees paid **in full** with completed application; or
- Fees paid **monthly** (after 1/3 of total membership fees are paid) with completed application. NOTE: Either a credit card or pre-dated checks is required for monthly payment plan.

Monthly Payment Plan Requirements:

- a. A minimum payment equal to one third (1/3) of annual Membership fee is due when application is submitted.
- b. One (1) payment each month shall be made to the shul each month for a maximum of nine (9) consecutive months.
- c. Either a valid **credit or debit card** OR **pre-dated monthly checks** are required upon submission of application for the purpose of collecting monthly payments and/or outstanding fees.

Special Requests:

Young Israel Aish Las Vegas continues to provide a spiritual, educational and friendly Orthodox Jewish environment that is open to ALL Jewish locals, regardless of their ability to pay for annual membership. In order for Y.I. Aish to maintain this open-arms policy, it is imperative that ALL who enjoy the benefits of the shul contribute toward its efforts and needs.

Applicants desiring the benefits of membership but are unable to pay the minimum annual membership fees are encouraged to schedule a meeting with the shul's Membership Committee Chair, Hadassa Lefkowitz at (702) 280-7078. Hadassa will request a member of the Board of Directors to attend this confidential meeting and to consult on a review of the specific request.

Also at this meeting, Applicants will be advised of the additional materials and information required by the Board of Directors when considering such requests.
